## MIXING GUIDELINES

### Super Tough Dilution

16 oz. / Quart  
64 oz. / Gallon

### Extra Heavy Dilution

8 oz. / Quart  
32 oz. / Gallon

### Heavy Dilution

4 oz. / Quart  
16 oz. / Gallon

### Light Dilution

1 - 2 oz. / Quart  
4 - 8 oz. / Gallon

### Carpet Machine

8 oz. / Gallon - Cold  
4 oz. / Gallon - Hot

### Heated Dip Tanks

1-80 or 1-100 @ 160° F

### High Pressure / Steam

1-50 or 1-100 Cold  
1-100 or 1-200 Hot

### Bath Cleaner

4 oz. Spectrum + 2 oz. Vinegar / Quart  
16 oz. Spectrum + 8 oz. Vinegar / Gallon

### Bleach Cleaner

4 oz. Spectrum + 2 oz. Bleach / Quart  
16 oz. Spectrum + 8 oz. Bleach / Gallon

### Glass Cleaner

1/4 oz. Spectrum + 1/2 oz. Vinegar / Quart  
1 oz. Spectrum + 2 oz. Vinegar / Gallon

### Hydrogen Peroxide Cleaner

4 oz. Spectrum + 4 oz. H<sub>2</sub>O<sub>2</sub> / Quart  
16 oz. Spectrum + 16 oz. H<sub>2</sub>O<sub>2</sub> / Gallon

## TEXTURED CEILINGS

The Hydrogen Peroxide Mixture may be used on **Blown Textured (Popcorn) Ceilings, Drop Type Ceiling Tiles, and Painted Ceilings**. To **protect furniture** - cover with a plastic drop cloth. When spraying next to wall coverings - test small area for **color fastness**. Since this job requires spraying overhead, **wear protective eye wear** to avoid accidental contact. Should spray get in eyes - **flush with water**.

Depending upon the size of the area to be cleaned, mix in a clean **Garden Type Pump Sprayer**. **Pre-treat** tough stain areas prior to starting. Spray Ceiling with as **fine a mist** as possible working back and forth being careful **not** to saturate material causing drips - it is best to apply **two light** coats rather than one heavy coat. Check areas to make sure ceiling is **uniformly** covered with solution. Wipe spray from walls, woodwork, and windows.

When cleaning Painted Ceilings or Hard Surface Ceiling Tiles - wipe excess spray from surface. Drop Ceiling metal tracks require wiping to prevent spotting.

### Water Spots

Ceilings that have been stained from water should be pre-treated with Spectrum Bleach Cleaner and allowed 20 - 30 minutes working time prior to starting entire cleaning process. Do not mix Hydrogen Peroxide until ready to start. Check water spots prior to starting and if necessary, repeat above process.

Some stained ceilings may require a second application. It should be noted that some stains cannot be removed by SPECTRUM or any other product.
